

What we love about our home on Hawks Nest court

We've been totally pleased with home's setting in the Hawks View Development for many reasons.

- Our 1.5 acre hilltop lot is surrounded by full growth trees on three sides. On the fourth (West) side we enjoy a many mile Vista, gorgeous and ever-changing sunset views and a nice view of Holy Hill Cathedral. On the 4th of July, we can see and enjoy fireworks displays from about 6 surrounding cities and municipalities.
- We love our quiet Cul de Sac and our neighbors who are friendly and as committed to maintaining their homes and landscapes as we have been.
- It's only a 3 minute walk to the Richfield park where we enjoy the walking trails and kid's play areas.
- Richfield recently added a Fire Station in Richfield Park. Emergency responders are less than ½ mile away.
- We're about 3 miles from Highway 41/45 for easy access to the greater Milwaukee area.
- There are lots of opportunities for hiking and biking in the area. The Ice Age Trail is 3 miles away, Pike Lake State Park is 15 minutes away and the roads around Holy Hill are both challenging and beautiful.

We designed our home to be friendly for visiting family, entertaining and enjoying views of nature at her best. We have done extensive upgrades during the past year. Here are a few of the features.

- We are foodies who enjoy entertaining, so our kitchen was designed to be the heart of the home. It is large and open, so cooks can work together. They can chat with folks at the snack bar, or in the open dinette area, family room, parlor and wet bar. We installed new countertops and a Subway tile backsplash in May of 2018.
- The lower level includes a large theatre room (with 5 channel sound wired in-wall), and a full kitchen. We've enjoyed many football games and movies with pizza and snacks in this area.
- The Master bedroom suite has a three-sided turret with large windows that face West for great views. A large walk in closet has custom cabinetry, multiple shelves for shoes and other items and ten built in drawers.
- Nearly every window is up-sized and provides enjoyable views of our custom landscaped yard.
- The majority of the yard, plantings and garden can and watered by an in-ground sprinkler system.

A few other items we appreciate.

- Our home has lots of open space for little ones to play and move about.
- The lower level includes a work shop that now is used for wood working but could be used for any craft. The workshop is accessible from indoors as well as a stairway connecting to the garage. The fourth bath is next to the workshop and garage stairway.
- We have many large, well designed storage areas throughout the home.
- Since late 2017, we refinished our hardwood floors and painted the interior and exterior of the home.
- A large row of raspberry plants bears lots of berries in our fenced garden plot.
